Year 11 Student information for live lessons during isolation:



From <u>Thursday 30th September</u> we will be starting to use Google Classroom and the Google Meet applications to be able to provide you lessons with increased content and interactivity where appropriate.

Live lessons can take a number of forms:

- Teachers delivering a lesson to camera to class(es) of students watching on Google Classroom
- Teachers delivering while running a PowerPoint/Google Slideshow and asking for questions.
- Pre-recorded lessons of either of the above.
- Live tutorials: Teachers posting some work onto Google classroom and then being available online to deal with any queries you send them.

Please be aware that not every lesson may be taken by your own class teacher as it may that another teacher is better placed to deliver the content you need.

Links to live lessons will be placed on in the appropriate class in Google Classroom.

The table on the next page indicates when your live lessons are scheduled during your absence from school

You can use a range of technology to access these lessons including; a PC, laptop, Tablet PC, Apple mac or a smart phone (this this is the most limited approach).

You were given passwords for Google Suite log-in on Monday 28th September. The use of a camera and microphone is not required to engage with the lessons. Though access to sound is very helpful.



Student protocols for live lessons:

When joining a Google Meet lesson with staff, please be aware of and the follow the following guidelines:

- 1. Be aware of the dates and times for live lessons. Please ensure that you log-in and are ready for these in good time.
- 2. Google meet links must not be shared with anyone outside of your own class.
- 3. It is your decision whether to join with a video camera for a lesson, they are not required to be able to engage with content. There may be times when your teacher disables all participants' cameras as they think that is most appropriate. You will however, need sound enabled to be able to hear the content being delivered as well a microphone to be able to respond to questions.
- 4. If you are joining with a camera facility, please make you sure you are in an appropriate, quiet location for a lesson and ensure you are appropriately dressed.
- 5. As well as being able to respond to teachers verbally, google meet has a chat facility where you can ask questions and receive a response.



- 6. Please remember that all activity is recordable so please respond appropriately at all times.
- 7. More than anything, remember these are learning opportunities being provided so that you can make better progress. Approach them with the positive, determined mind-set you do all of your lessons. Take every opportunity to improve.
- 8. You must complete all work required from a lesson. Work identified by her teachers for marking can be turned in in Google Classroom.
