### **Important Reminders**

- 1. **Masks** The guidance around masks in schools is unchanged and will not change again until May at the earliest. In other words, students are expected to wear masks in classrooms and when moving around in buildings. Please ensure that your daughter has an appropriate supply of masks when she returns to school and that she knows how to wear one properly to help keep you and all members of our school community that bit safer.
- 2. Home Testing Your daughter was provided with enough tests for the duration of the holiday before we broke up. Please test your daughter on the Sunday evening before returning to school to ensure that she is safe to return. If the test is positive, please book a confirmatory PCR test via the NHS website <a href="https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test">https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test</a> and let us know by emailing <a href="masstesting@hollylodge.liverpool.sch.uk">masstesting@hollylodge.liverpool.sch.uk</a>. We would encourage you to follow the government guidelines on home testing twice each week once the guidelines for this are issued shortly. We are not aware at this time if any more kits will be provided to school given the Government plans to make them available to everyone.
- 3. **Punctuality** The vast majority of students are managing to arrive in school on time each morning but we have rising numbers of lates in the morning in recent weeks. Please ensure that your daughter is on time on site by 8.25 each morning. If punctuality does not improve, we will have to re-institute some socially distanced detentions at breaktimes this term. We will warn parents if this is to be the case.
