Police Cadets

An opportunity to take part in a voluntary scheme for 2 hours a week on a Saturday morning for students in Year 11 and 12. The scheme, which has been running for a number of years, offers an opportunity for young people to have an insight into the work of Merseyside Police. The scheme aims to engage and develop young people, to help them engage them with their communities and encourage them to become positive role models and ambassadors among their peers. While many cadets do consider a career in the police service, this is not always the case and is certainly not a bar to recruitment, as most of the skills and experiences they obtain will be transferable to other walks of life.

STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) Opportunity

Insight into University (previously known as Headstart & Inspire) is a comprehensive on-line course allowing students to experience STEM studies at university and the career opportunities that these subjects lead to. It will provide access to information on university and student life, STEM projects and activities set by leading UK universities and global STEM companies, first year undergraduate lectures, live interactive sessions with academics, admissions tutors, employers and current students. STEM Opportunity

The virtual Routes into STEM course allows students aged 13+ (S3 & S4) to recognise the variety of opportunities available to them after taking their GCSEs, it will provide them access to key information on different pathways; college, university and STEM career. Diverse live interactive sessions will take place during half term or summer holidays allowing students to listen and ask questions to a variety of STEM professionals and student ambassadors. Students will also choose from a range of exciting projects, developed by University and Industry partners, to work on during the course.



Upon successful completion of the course, students will receive a Bronze Industrial Cadets award and be in a position to make a more informed decision about their future. The course can be completed around other commitments and studies to suits individual circumstances. The course is open to all students aged 13+ and it is suitable for all academic abilities. All that is required is a genuine interest in STEM subjects and inquisitiveness about what the future can hold for them.

There is a small cost to take part, but bursaries are available to cover this.
