## **Mobile Phones, Headphones and Smart Watches**

We have changed our rules around mobile devices for all years this year as they have continued to cause conflict between staff and students due to their misuse. Therefore, from September, use of all such devices will be banned from the school site at all times as follows.

**Phones** – must be switched off and placed in bags as soon as students enter site. Any phone seen at any time during the school day will be confiscated.

**Headphones** – students must not wear headphones on site. If these are seen at any time on site they will be confiscated, along with the phone they will be connected to.

**Smart Watches** – are banned by examination boards, and we have decided to ban them as well to get the students into good habits. Again, any smart watch seen will be confiscated.

**Confiscation:** Any member of staff can confiscate any item seen. If the student follows instructions straight away, the device will be returned to them at the end of the day. If the student refuses and other staff must become involved, the device will be stored securely until a parent can collect. Serious defiance will result in further sanctions up to and including suspension.

## **Uniform Policy**

- All students should always wear their blazer.
- Outdoor jackets must be plain black and waterproof. Jackets of any other colour will be confiscated and returned at the end of the day. An outdoor jacket does not replace a blazer.
